OUR PROGRAMS

INFANTS

6 WEEKS TO 12 MONTHS

We believe in a practical, hands-on approach to caring for your baby while letting them explore and develop to their true potential. That's why you will NEVER see exersaucers, bouncy seats, or swings inside our classrooms!

THEIR EDUCATION BEGINS NOW

In the Highscope Education Approach, infants learn through discovery with their teachers – this is called active participatory learning. During active learning, teachers encourage infants and toddlers to discover the world around them by exploring and playing. Development and learning are secured by trusting relationships with teachers, who are close at hand to support children as they play.

When your baby explores, she is learning and developing her brain. When your baby needs comfort, we will be there to soothe him and make him smile.





FOR YOUR ULTIMATE PEACE OF MIND, THE PARENT APP KEEPS YOU UP-TO-DATE

Receive real-time photos and notifications of naps, diaper changes, bottles, and feedings.

YOU CAN COMFORTABLY EXPECT:

- WARM BOTTLES & SNUGGLES

Bottles are warmed in Kozii-Kinde warmers and our teachers complete additional safety checks before feeding a bottle. Every infant is held while feeding a bottle. This is a special bonding time between the teacher and baby!

- "SAFE SLEEP" NAPS

We follow our Safe Sleep Policy and infants are always placed to sleep on their backs with no items in their crib.

- DIAPER CHANGES - OFTEN!

Diapers are changed as needed, never exceeding two hours in-between changes. Parents provide diapers while we provide the wipes.

- A CLEAN, SHOE-FREE ZONE

Our infant space is a no-shoes room. As babies learn to crawl, get belly time, and explore their environment, we want to keep the environment clean and safe.



TODDLER CHILD CARE

12 MONTHS TO 2.5 YEARS

Our Toddler Program is for children 12 months to 2 ½ years old. As Toddlers turn 2 ½ they enter our Preschool 2s and 3s classroom. Here is where they focus on Preschool readiness and have more structure in their day.

THE HIGHSCOPE CURRICULUM FOR FUTURE SCHOOL SUCCESS

Our HighScope Curriculum is implemented in our toddler and transitional preschool classrooms. Our teachers complete a full week orientation training, monthly continuous HighScope trainings, and receive on-the-spot support and feedback from a Curriculum Director once a week. As toddlers enter transitional preschool, they are exposed to more structure in their daily schedule. Active learning is always a pillar of our approach.

Preschool 2s and 3s

2.5 YEARS TO POTTY TRAINED

Our Preschool Program is for children 2 ½ years old to potty trained. As toddlers turn 2 ½ they enter our preschool 2s and 3s classroom. Here is where they focus on preschool readiness and have more structure in their day.

While potty training is encouraged and possibly started in the toddler program, it is heavily focused on in transitional preschool.

PRESCHOOL 3s and 4s

POTTY TRAINED 3 TO 4 YEARS

Our Preschool classroom is designed for children who are potty trained and 3 to 4 years old. Preschool has a structured daily routine with more focus on emergent writing and phonics.

HighScope Preschool Curriculum is implemented in all our Preschool Classrooms. Our teachers complete a full week orientation training, monthly continuous Highscope trainings and receive on the spot support and feedback from a Curriculum Director once a week.

MATH SKILLS STARTS NOW!

Math is an essential aspect in many parts of each preschooler's day. You can find math in our art area, toy area, and book section of the classroom! Counting, sorting, classifying, and identifying are all math skills that are experienced and progressed during preschool.

We implement the Zoophonics program at all ages in order to encourage reading and writing. Zoophonics is a Highscope Program that encourages reading beginning with the most important word to each child: their name!

PRE-K

4 YEARS

Our Pre-K classroom is designed for children who are 4 years old. Pre-K has a structured daily routine with more focus on emergent writing and phonics.

The routine is set day-to-day, with a consistent schedule that allows children to recognize and be aware of what events are going to take place. Each part of the day is signified by our curriculum and includes a variety of choices for children to choose from based on their interests and teachers' scaffolding on various learning areas. Teachers use an assessment tool to track developmental areas to set goals and prepare for Kindergarten.

THE ZOOPHONICS BUILDS READING AND WRITING SKILLS

Our Zoophonics program encourages reading and writing in all kids this age. Zoophonics is a Highscope Program that encourages reading beginning with the most important word to each child: their name!

WE TRACK AND REPORT PROGRESS

Yes, this is when we start with the parent-teacher conferences! We use the app as the assessment tool to track child's progress. This assessment tool and results are discussed at parent-teacher conferences twice a year. While teachers and parents get the opportunity to meet twice per school year, these anecdotal notes and goals are shared often with open communication.



SMALL GROUP SIZES AND INDEPENDENT LEARNING

Group times are an essential part of our daily schedule. During small group time, each child participates in an activity that allows them to have their own materials and choice of how to use them. This is done with their primary caregiver/group. Large group time consists of one activity that the entire classroom engages in together. The difference from preschool to pre-k is that at the pre-k level, the activities will become more challenging to expand their development capabilities.

READY TO WRITE NOW!

Our goal for your pre-k child is to continue developing their established milestones, one of the most significant ones being writing. We will share activities that include using writing tools such as pencils, markers, and crayons to write out words which will continue embracing their fine motor development and hand control.

All of our vehicles are equipped with first aid kits and GPS. Your child's school schedule and emergency card are always carried when picking up or dropping off your child. At the beginning of the school year, our drivers communicate with your child's school to designate a safe and appropriate pick-up and drop-off area for children attending The Learning Tree.

TIME FOR HOMEWORK HELP

We understand parents are busy and encourage time for homework to be started.

THE CURRICULUM IS BASED ON YOUR CHILD'S SPECIFIC NEEDS

The curriculum for the School-Age Program differs as the children spend most of their time at school, and each child needs different guidance outside of school. Goals for the School-Age Program include:
